



TRANSPORTATION NOTICE PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING I-15 NORTH DESIGN-BUILD PROJECT

Purpose of Meeting:

The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is working to improve the I-15 corridor from the I-15/US 95 "Spaghetti Bowl" interchanges to Craig Rd. in North Las Vegas. The project's purpose is to relieve congestion and improve traffic flow in the I-15 corridor in response to continued growth in the Las Vegas Valley.

Improvements to this section of interstate will include:

- widening throughout the corridor
- reconstruction of ramps and interchanges, and
- new sound walls and landscape improvements.

NDOT will conduct a public information meeting to provide the members of the community with the updated landscaping/aesthetic plans for this corridor, as well as information on project design and construction schedule. The focus of this meeting is the I-15 from the I-15/US 95 "Spaghetti Bowl" interchanges to Craig Rd. in North Las Vegas.

The public information meeting will be held on **Thursday, January 24, 2008** at **Kit Carson Elementary School, 1735 D Street, Las Vegas, NV 89106**, from **4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.** in the multi-purpose room. The school is located between Lake Mead and Owens on D Street.

Members of the public are invited to attend the Public Information Meeting at their convenience any time between 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. There will be a brief presentation at 5:30 p.m., followed by a short comment period. Prior to and after the presentation and comment period, the meeting will be open format, with an opportunity for attendees to submit their comments in writing or in person. This meeting format increases the opportunity for public comment and provides for one-on-one discussion with staff involved with the project.
